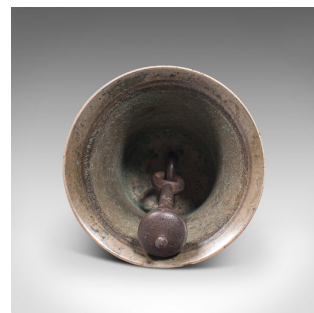
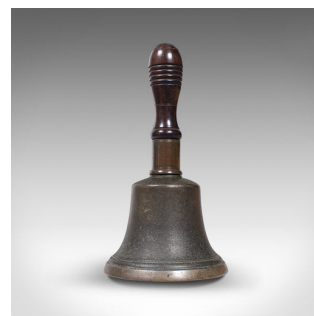
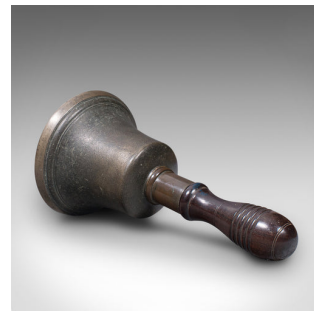


Antique Schoolmaster's Hand Bell, English, Brass, Lignum Vitae, Victorian, 1850
