- Hand-carved craftsmanship decorates each chair with Gothic overtones
- Scroll pediment top rail with fleur-de-lys motif to centre
- Archetypal Green Man masques decorate the seat backs
- Rails carved with pattern details and motif
- Wide, flat seat bases show appealing figuring
- Shaped aprons with tooled patterns accentuate the lower aprons to front and sides
- Block knees host carved foliate sections
- Superb cupped legs to the front standing on tall bun feet
