- Select oak shows deep caramel hues and fine grain interest
- Distinctive octagonal form with open gallery and useful under tier
- Foliate carved centrepiece set within a diamond motif
- Carved and gently rolled, the table edge sits above a shaped apron
- Under tier enthusiastically decorated with eight leaf carved panels
- Raised upon an octet of bun feet

This is a charming and profusely decorated antique octagonal table, with appealing Aesthetic Period taste and Gothic form. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
