This is a vintage fireside knight companion. An English, bronzed medieval figure with a set of fireside tools, dating to the early 20th century, circa 1930.

- A noble and striking companion knight, ready to stand guard in front of the fireplace
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in very good order
- Bronzed cast metal radiates warm copper hues with light patination
- Highly detailed figure with impressive medieval armour
- Held aloft, the halberd-form poker rests between the knight's hands
- Smaller poker and coal scoop sit neatly within the reverse of the knight
- Standing at close to a metre tall with poker, the knight himself is 66cm (26") in height

Presented upon a tiered, square plinth base

• Maker's mark to rear for Nestor with registered design numbers and 'Made in England' mark

• Inscription reads 'From the model by Harry Banks B.W.S. 101'

• Registered numbers also appear upon the halberd and base
