- Front apron frieze accentuated with drop pendant finials to each corner

- Distinctive trestle feet with unusual bobbin turned feet and circular motif
- Fascinating inverted bobbin turning to the uniting stretcher rail

This is a highly decorative antique stretcher table, with superb turned detail and gothic overtones. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
