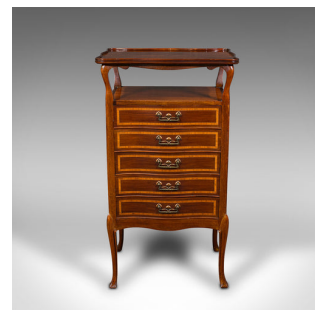


## Antique Music Cabinet, English, Document, Specimen Drawers, Edwardian, C.1910
