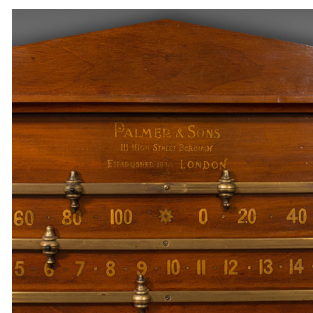
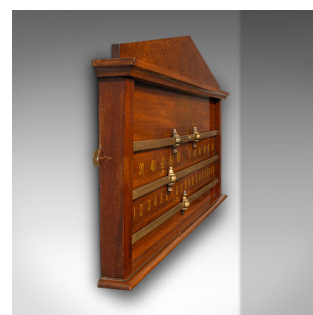


Antique Billiards Scoreboard, English, Snooker, Palmer & Sons, London, Edwardian
