This is an antique master specimen chest on stand. An English, satinwood document archive or collector's cabinet, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Of a striking, superior finish - perfect for the most treasured of items
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in very good order
- Dashing satinwood presents incredible figuring and light caramel hues
- Deep moulded fascia panels add to the distinctive appearance
 - Shallow sarcophagus top with a fall-front fascia aids access to the set of six graduated drawers
- Front panel dressed with an inset brass lined lock – key absent
- With oak drawers boxes, each is dressed with quality brass recessed cup handles
- Five drawers with an internal height of 3.5cm (1.5") with the final drawer set at 6cm (2.25")
 - Raised upon a quartet of serpentine cabriole legs and united with a H-stretcher

This is a striking antique master specimen chest on stand, graced with captivating satinwood figuring, rich in colour and grain interest. Exuding quality and a solid finish, this is a specimen chest fit for the finest collections. Solid joints and construction delivered waxed, polish ...
