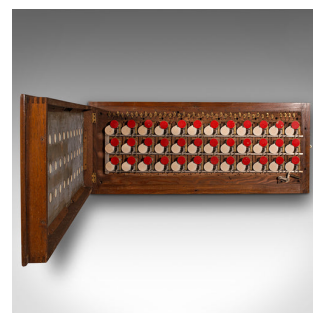
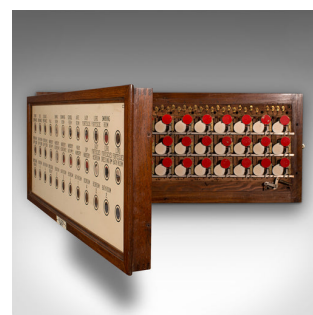
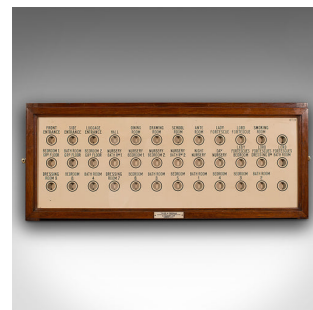


Large Antique Country House Butler's Bell Board, English, Room Panel, Victorian
