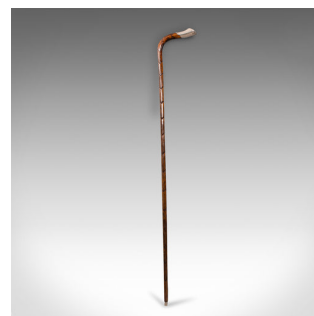
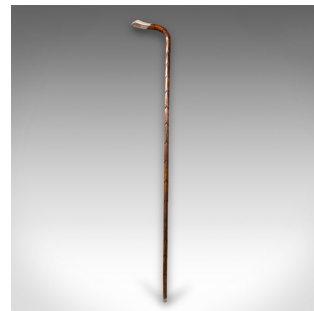


Antique Gentleman's Walking Stick, English, Coromandel, Silver, Cane, Edwardian

- Maker's initial for BJ, with the Lion Passant and London's Leopard assay mark
- Further hallmarked with the date letter I, for 1904
