 - Elegant arms cascade gently from the top rail, resting upon slender turned balusters
- \bullet Raised upon gently tapered front legs with swept feet to rear and united by a H-stretcher

This is a superb antique elbow chair, with beautiful colour and quality craftsmanship. Unmarked as such, the Sheraton influence affords the chair an unabashed elegance. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
