This is an antique secretaire sideboard. An English, mahogany drop-front correspondence cabinet, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Of excellent proportion and graced with Art Nouveau taste
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order throughout
- Select stocks show fine grain interest and deep caramel hues
- Quality bevelled mirror plates with a desirable light foxing and bright appearance
- Breakfront pediment accentuated with dentil moulding over a pair of narrow alcove corner shelves
- Upper cabinet hosts a pair of generously sized shelves behind the large mirrored doors
 - Wide sideboard surface with a tiered edge moulding sits above the cabinet base
 - ullet Dressed throughout with working locks key present
- Superb secretaire front with carved frieze framing the pair of brass drop handles over shaped backplates
- Accessed by push button to each side, the writing surface sits ahead of a suite of storage compartments
 - Inset green leather skiver with gold tooling in original order
