- Rare and unusual, this fascinating table presents a fine appearance and versatility
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order throughout
- Select stocks show fine grain interest and deep russet hues
- Dressed with faux drawer fascia, with a pair of useful drawers to the leading edge
- Of great proportion, the top opens to one end on brass hinges
- The fold over top can be held securely upon an articulated rest arm
- Each drawer fascia dressed with a pair of turned pulls and inset brass lined locks – key absent
- Attractive tapering turned legs ride smoothly upon a quartet of brass castors

This is a delightful antique cartographer's table, the inset folio to one end offers potential storage for many uses. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
