This is an antique campaign correspondence box. An Anglo-Indian, teak and bone inlaid colonial writing case with fitted interior, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Enticing writing box with a delightful array of hidden compartments
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Select Teak shows fine grain interest and bright russet hues
- Inlaid throughout with crisp, white bone for decorative appeal
- Lid opens to reveal a fully-featured, convertible interior
- Dressed with an inset lock to the drop-front fascia – key absent
- The fascia rests at a canted angle to provide a writing slope
- Two document trays offers seven and eight compartments respectively
- Small cabinet to rear lifting outwards, with an internal pin lever accessing a hidden drawer

- Dressed with a small bone handle, the field panel doors open to reveal small storage shelves

- Set within the fitted frame, a final hidden drawer can be extended with the pin lever
