- Arranged as a pair of small drawers over two of full width
- Each dressed with small circular pulls, framed with fluted carving detail
- Shaped, brass faux escutcheons to each drawer fascia — key absent
- Standing upon a quartet of squat bun feet beneath a shallow, tapering plinth

This is a fascinating small antique apprentice chest of drawers, with an attractive finish ideal for use as a jewellery box or tea caddy. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
