This is an antique serpentine console table. An English, mahogany reception hall, side or vestibule table, dating to the early Victorian period, circa 1840.

- Low profile, wall-mount form perfect for the entrance hall or an alcove beside a fireplace
- The sinuous chamfered table edge falls away gracefully, sitting proud of the serpentine apron below
- Canted corners sit atop the oblique knees, accentuated here with scrolled flourishes and carved motif
- Superb cabriole legs decorated with elaborate scrolled toes in the classical French manner

This is a striking antique serpentine console table, the expressive forms and detail a hallmark of the early Victorian age in furniture craftsmanship. Solid joints and construction delivered waxed polished and ready for the home
