This is an antique writer's desk. An English, mahogany side or serving table, dating to the Georgian period, circa 1800.

- Of superb proportion and fine presentation
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order throughout
- Select stocks show fine grain interest and rich caramel hues
- Decorated with quality boxwood inlays and stringing
- Generous width to the top, with an appealing tiered edge
- Front fascia hosting two drawers, with a flying centre drawer
- Each dressed with ornate brass drop handles over pierced foliate backplates
- Pleated quarterfoil carvings adorn the shoulders to either side
- Usefully high at 84.5cm (33.25") for the taller person
- Each corner hosts dashing turned balusters over cupped knees
- Stout block legs taper to a square section foot
