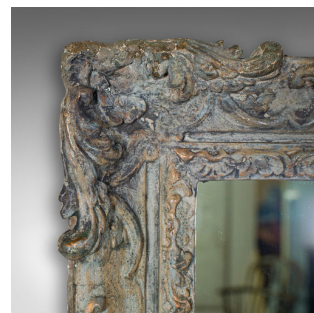


Antique Decorative Mirror, English Gilt Gesso, Glass, Wall, Art Frame, Victorian

This is an antique decorative mirror. An English, gilt gesso and glass art frame, dating to the Victorian period and later, circa 1900.

- Fascinating antique frame, formerly used to house exhibited art
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Bold gilt gesso frame shows appealing weathered hues
- Later mirror plate free of marks and offers a bright reflective appearance
- Prominent corners decorated with scrolled leaf detail
- Dressed to the rear with a hanging wire for ease of mounting
- Artist's detail by David Cox (1915 - 1979), of Porthmeor Studio, St. Ives, Cornwall
- Remnants of Royal Academy Exhibition labels add further interest
