This is an antique butler's duty box. An English, walnut tool or sewing case, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Exquisite figuring accentuating the versatile duty case
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in very good order
- Select walnut stocks shows striking grain interest
- Wonderful depth of colour to the warm caramel and russet hues
- Lid opens to reveal the fitted interior, resting on an articulated arm
- Three section lift-out tool tray, revealing a small compartment below
- Set along the side of the interior, a removable pin box with green felt cushion
- Beneath, a fitted cover hides a small box with sliding lid - ideal for bits, needles etc
- Impressively clean, the interior boasts a similar quality finish to the case exterior
- Dressed with a small brass lock escutcheon — key absent
- Raised upon a quartet of short bracket feet at each corner
