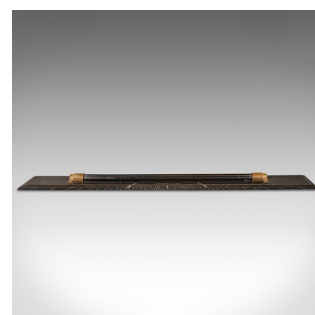




Antique Nautical Rolling Ruler, English, Maritime, Draughtsman, Captain Field
