This is a vintage shipwright's tool chest. An English, cedar and pine craftsman's work trunk, dating to the mid 20th century, circa 1940.

- Wonderful maritime charm, offering great storage or as a distinctive coffee table
- Displays a desirable aged patina with light service wear, commensurate with age
- Ebonised pine exterior offers deep black hues, with stout steel straps to corners
- Clean, bright cedar interior beams warm caramel hues upon opening
- Fascinating, inset One Shilling coin to the lid, dated to 1947
- Deep lid opens upwards, coming to rest upon a rear brace
- Removable tool tray insert, sliding freely to aid access to the lower trunk space
- Additional rotating tool rests adorn the inside of the lid
- Engraved to the side and beneath the lid edge with 'Plymouth Docks, 1943'
- Stencilled fascia reads B.R. Tucker, Shipwright - M.C.D. 22604
- Dressed with a diamond-shape lock escutcheon — in working order, key present
