- Tapering slightly along its form, the stand hosting an internal drip tray
- Quality tin tray removable for clearing water accumulated within
- Standing upon a stout circular foot for assured stability

This is a superb antique coopered umbrella stand, ideal for large umbrellas or a selection of canes and walking sticks in a reception hall. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home or institution.
