This is a pair of antique nightstands. An English, mahogany sarcophagus top bedside or fireside cabinet, dating to the William IV period and later, circa 1835.

- Impressive form and finish, ideal for the grand bedroom or lounge

- Deep in profile, with a striking pagoda or sarcophagus top
- Distinctive reverse cavetto crown mouldings accentuated with chased lobe borders
- Wide field panel door dressed with a brass drop pendant handle upon a quarterfoil backplate

backplate

- Opening to the interior with an upper shelf, set back within the cabinet
- Both cabinets replete with inset, brass lined locks – untested, key absent
- Distinctive scalloped corners adorn the front edges
- Raised upon a deep plinth foot, with bracketed feet to the rear
