This is a pair of antique decorative candelabra. A French, silver nickel 4-branch centrepiece candlestick, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Ornately decorated candelabra with appealing heft

- 20mm (0.75") diameter nozzles sit within foliate decorated mounts
- Arranged with a prominent central candle nozzle
- Quartet of branches set upon double scroll arms with leaf decor
- Striking oak leaf brackets accentuate the support column
- Raised upon a stout alabaster base with four discrete ball feet
