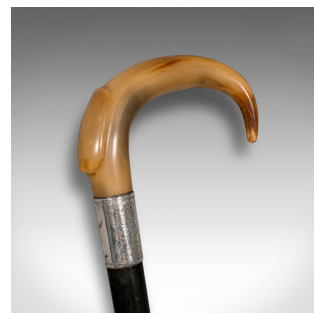


Antique Gentleman's Walking Stick, English, Ebonised, Horn, Victorian, C.1850
