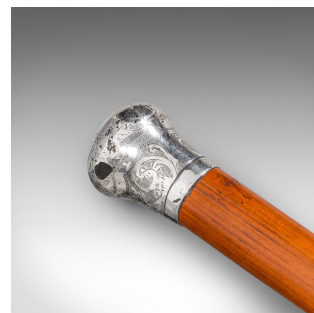
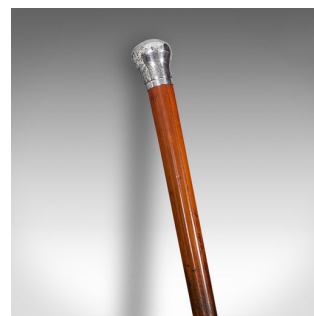


Antique Dandy's Walking Cane, English, Fruitwood Stick, Silver Handle, Victorian
