This is an antique open armchair. A French, walnut salon chair with quality damask upholstery, dating to the early Victorian period, circa 1840.

- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Striking walnut show frame presents deep caramel hues and fine grain interest
- Lightly aged silk damask upholstery ready to enjoy as is, with appealing foliate pattern
- Gently angled back rest with domed top, nestled between a pair of deep wings
- Broad, cushioned arms terminate in striking carved knuckles over cabriole supports
- Beautifully crafted show frame hosts cabochon and fanned detail throughout
- Traditionally stuffed and deeply cushioned seat set at a comfortable height of 46cm (18")
- The removable cushion offers deep under thigh support at 59.5cm (23.5")
- Raised upon a quartet of squat cabriole legs at each corner
