This is a set of 8 antique dining chairs. An English, walnut carver and seat with upholstered cushions, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Graced with delightful walnut stocks and of appealing form

- Warm caramel hues to the select walnut beneath a wax polish finish
- Further distinguished with fine grain interest throughout
- Two dashing carvers accompany a suite of six chairs
- Traditionally stuffed cushions, dressed with a quality upholstery and adorned with press stud trim
- Distinctive, pierced sash-shape upper rail adorned with carved motif
- Decorated lower sash and supports with foliate patera carvings
- Long, graceful arms to the carver sit upon turned and fluted supports
- Sash lower apron with carved shell to centre, flanked with scrolled brackets
- Front legs repeat the flute column finish with a pair of turned collars
