- Select oak stocks present fine grain interest throughout
- Rich caramel hues beam beneath a quality wax polish finish
- Arrangement of five graduated drawers, dressed with pairs of small pulls
- Pair of hinged brackets hold the drawers closed, adding security
- Dressed with an inset, working lock to the right –key present
- Left-hand bracket replete with sliding clasp mechanism

This is a charming antique Wellington chest of drawers, of small proportion and offering storage for the collector of petite specimens or collectibles. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
