This is an antique Sutherland table. An English, walnut gate-leg occasional table, dating to the late Regency period, circa 1830.

- Impressively figured table in the traditional Sutherland form
- Displaying a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Quality walnut stocks present superb grain interest beneath a wax polish finish
- Light caramel hues present a pleasingly warm glow
- Of useful breakfast table or tea service proportion when extended
- Wide drop leaves extend the seating area comfortably for four
- In the folded position, the narrow profile ideal for storing in the smaller room
- Articulated gate legs provide support for each leaf at 90 degrees
- Elegantly turned baluster legs united with a stretcher rail between arched trestle feet
 - The whole riding smoothly upon a set of six brass castors
