- Quality glass plate presents a clear, bright view to the shelving within
- Striking carved pediment adds decoration to the door
- Opens to reveal a suite of four removable shelves
- Dressed to the side with a rotating brass clasp – aged lock, no key
- Finished with a pair of small brass mounting loops for ease of hanging

This is an appealing antique shop's display cabinet, with an attractive oak and glass finish. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready to display.
