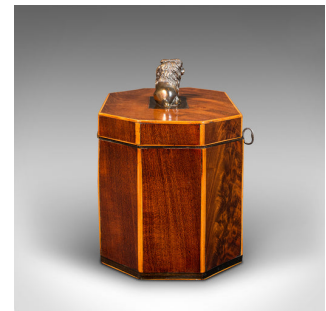


Antique Decorative Tea Caddy, English, Keepsake Box, Figurative, Lion, Regency
