This is an antique writing desk. An English, mahogany and Amboyna office, study or drawing room table, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Striking Amboyna drawer fronts present beautifully
- Arranged as a pair of useful drawers below a wide writing surface with gently rolled edge
- Each drawer dressed with a pair of brass drop handles, set upon shaped and pierced backplates
- Quality drawer fronts dovetail skilfully with clean pitch pine boxes
- Eye-catching shaped brackets accentuate the lower fascia
- Turned legs at each corner, with cupped and collared decorations
- Riding smoothly upon a quartet of articulated brass castors
