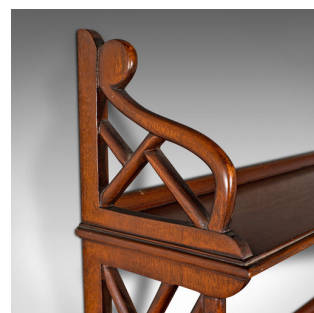


Vintage Georgian Revival Whatnot, English, Mounted Shelves, Late 20th Century
