- Pleasing weight of 1.06 kg (2.33 lb) and a cool, tactile feeling in the hand
- The domed lid topped with a plume of feathers finial and foliate border detail
- Front and rear fascia decorated with quality plume of feather relief
- Chased foliate borders repeat upon the upper and lower edges
- The pleasingly clean interior features a removable lead trapper
