This is an antique drawing room tea caddy. An English, flame mahogany sarcophagus with glass mixer, dating to the Regency period, circa 1820.

- Superb craftsmanship with striking decorative appearance
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Select flame stocks present superior grain interest
- Warm caramel hues dazzle beneath a wax polish finish
- Distinctive sarcophagus top with domed and beaded centrepiece
- Dressed to the fascia with a small circular lock escutcheon – in working order, key present
- Pair of lidded canisters sit neatly within their recess, with a mixing glass to centre
- Canisters in appealing original order, with aged linings
- Mixing glass presents appealing cut detail with diamond patterns
- One small loss to the circumference of the rolled foot
- Glass resides within a violet velvet lined receptacle
