This is an antique elbow chair. An English, walnut carver in the Georgian Chippendale revival taste, dating to the mid Victorian period, circa 1860.

- Deep caramel hues beam beneath a wax polish finish
- Plume of Feathers carving adorns the cresting rail, with scrolled detail to ears
- Leading into a grand, pierced ribbon back splat with quarterfoil fretwork
- Sinuous arms host wonderful grain and tonality
- Each arm raised upon a striking, serpentine support
- Quality, later needlepoint foliate upholstery in good order
- Drop-in seat cushion at a comfortable height of 47cm (18.5")
- Can be easily reupholstered to individual taste
