This is a very large antique museum showcase. An English, walnut glazed display cabinet on ornate stand by Holland & Sons of London, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Exceptional craftsmanship evident to this large exhibition-standard showcase
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in very good order
- Select walnut stocks present fine grain interest and deep russet hues
- Glazed with superb original panels for a bright viewing experience
- Of tall trapezoid shape, with five windows casting light throughout the form
- Generously sized door to one end, dressed with two twist clasps
- Further appointed with an inset working lock — set of keys present
- Interior finished with a quality textile display base in a light golden hue
- Strikingly carved display base a visual spectacle
- Ornate carved field panels host portrait masks to each fascia
- Stout cupped and decorated legs taper to brass capped feet with inset roller ball
