This is a vintage decorative accent lamp. An English, cast alloy and copper converted medical heat lamp, dating to the early 20th century, circa 1930.

- Of fascinating form and decorative appeal, with a delightful finish
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Cast alloy frame presents dark grey tonality with foliate pattern detail
- Striking polished copper reflector shows warm amber hues
- Skilfully converted from a Barber Dark Emitter infra red heat lamp
- In period, the lamp was used to treat ailments at home using the principle of phototherapy
  - Cast Alloy roundel to centre reads 'The Barber Infra-Red Dark Emitter, 230/250 Volts
  - Distinctive wire cage sits proudly ahead of the reflector plate
  - Raised upon pair of small feet at the corner of the frame and a rear handle support
- Barber-Bournville of Birmingham specialised in heat lamps in the early to mid 20th century
  - Complete with a standard bayonet bulb and an in-line remote control
