This is an antique campaign chest. An English, camphorwood storage box or trunk, dating to the early Victorian period, circa 1850.

- Beautifully presented chest with fine figuring
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Camphorwood stocks present fine grain interest
- The whole basking in light caramel hues beneath the wax polish finish
- Stout lid dressed with an inset brass scallop pull and unmarked plaque to top
- Opens to reveal the strikingly clean storage compartment
- Brass caps to corners add reassuring stability to the trunk
- Pair of brass drop handles to the ends, with a shield lock escutcheon to fascia – key absent

This is a desirable antique campaign chest with a superb appearance. Ideal for storage throughout the home. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
