This is an antique gentleman's card table. An English, walnut master gaming table by James Phillips & Sons, dating to the early Victorian period, circa 1840.

- An exquisite example of early Victorian craftsmanship, with striking figuring
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in very good order
- Select walnut stocks present fine grain interest
- Delightful caramel hues radiate beneath a quality wax polish finish
- Rectangular top finished with a distinctive leather medallion to the centre
 - Rotating through 90 degrees with a firm action, the top extends to present the playing surface
- Bordered with fascinating burr walnut, the emerald green baize in superb order
- Useful drawer set within the fascia ideal for storing cards or cigars
- Drawer front dressed with an inset brass-lined lock – in working order, key present
- Maker's roundel to the drawer box for James Phillips & Sons Ltd, Bristol
- Striking shaped aprons and bold frieze shoulders decorate the body
