This is an antique artist's materials table. An English oak fold out companion stand by Roberson & amp; Co of London, dating to the mid Victorian period, circa 1870.

• Extraordinary artist's table by the renowned paint specialists C. Roberson & amp; Co

• Displays a desirable aged patina with light signs of artist's remnants commensurate with use

- Select oak stocks present fine grain interest with an abundance of medullary rays
- Superb caramel hues beam beneath a wax polish finish
- Arranged as an enclosed storage tray over a trio of drawers
- Opening in unison, the two compartment doors reveal a useful working area
- Lopers to each side extend to support the doors and provide a perch for drying brushes
 - Tin solvent pots for washing brushes sit neatly within their own recess
 - Removable pastels tray hosts up to 21 individual colours neatly
 - Brass lock escutcheon in Gothic revival taste untested, key absent

· Each drawer dressed with a distinctive drop handle over matched quarterfoil backplates
