This is an antique gentleman's cigar humidor. An English, burr walnut and cedar campaign smoker's box with Bramah lock, dating to the Regency period, circa 1820.

- Exquisite figuring and craftsmanship elevate this fine humidor
- Displaying a desirable aged patina throughout
- Burr walnut stocks present superior grain interest
- Striking, deep caramel hues beam beneath a wax polish finish
- Beautifully presented with a trio of cigar drawers enclosed within
- Top replete with an inset, unmarked brass plaque - ideal for personalisation
- Handles to each side aid ease of carriage, important in period for the travelling gent
- Fine ebonised stringing accentuates each edge of the distinguished case
- Door held securely with a famous Bramah lock – in working order, key present
 - Each drawer dressed with an inset brass handle, set within distinctive shaped backplates
 - Cedar drawer boxes arranged with two generous compartments and narrow trough to centre
