This is an antique gentleman's reading table. An English, mahogany adjustable cantilever writing desk, dating to the Victorian period, circa 1870.

- Exceptional versatility to this attractive, well-crafted table
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Select stocks present a superior grain interest throughout
- Rich caramel hues beam beneath a quality wax polish finish
- Sectional table top with one half hosting an adjustable reading stand
- Stand adjusts for angle through 14 positions, documents held in place with a shallow rest
 - Upper section rises by 15cm (6") upon a stout column with inset position tubes
 - Once situated, the top secured in place by a long metal pin with twist handle
 - Useful drawer to the right, with sectional compartment tray inset lock, key absent
 - Striking turned column with bulb and collar forms
 - Distinctive hyperboloid base with deep edge hosting delightful figuring
