This is an antique cased microscope. An English, black enamel scientific instrument by J. Swift & D. Swift & Swift amp; Son of London, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Enamelled metal body in striking black, with highly contrasting polished brass
- \bullet Mahogany carry box shows rich caramel hues and benefits from a working lock key present
 - Extendable eyepiece tube with a rack and pinion main focus guide
 - Slide stage dressed with a pair of rotary clips and annotated with a grid scale
 - Single objective mounted to the scope with a pair of accessory lenses within the box
 - \bullet Bright mirror beneath the slide holder, mounted on a rotating arm
 - Maker's mark in crisp white paint for J. Swift & Don, London
- The scope fits neatly within the carry case with segmented compartments for further accessories
 - Matched J. Swift lenses present in striking golden casings
