This is a very large antique partner's desk. An English, mahogany and leather twin pedestal desk by Maple & Co, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Exceptional proportion and arrangement to this grand desk

- Select stocks present fine grain interest and rich caramel hues
- Inset leather skiver to the top, embossed to the edge with repeat pattern
- The wide top supported upon a pair of deep pedestal bases
- Arrangement of drawers across the upper fascia with a double wide centre drawer
- Dressed with brass drop handles over distinctive shaped backplates
- Locks fitted throughout, in working order – set of four keys present
- Pedestal accentuated with field panels to the ends and to the cabinet door
- At the reverse of each pedestal, a bank of three graduated drawers
- One central drawer replete with the Maple & Co maker's emblem
