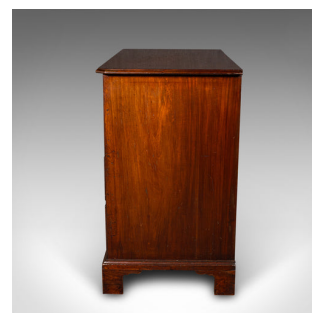


Antique Gentleman's Tallboy, English, Chest of Drawers, Georgian, Circa 1790

This is an antique tallboy. An English, mahogany and oak chest of drawers, dating to the Georgian period, circa 1790.

- Substantial drawer fronts at a thickness of 2.5cm (1") with oak drawer boxes
- Graced with appealing canted corners in the Georgian tradition
- Arranged as two upper drawers over three graduated, full width drawers
 - Each dressed with brass drop handles over circular backs and an inset lock escutcheon – key absent
 - Pleasingly clean drawer boxes benefit from the bountiful grain interest of English oak
 - Standing upon delightful ogee bracket feet to each corner

This is a superb antique chest of drawers, graced with striking grain interest and quality polished finished in caramel hues. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home
