- Raised upon six, stout block feet, the gate-leg pair rotating to support the leaves

This is a fascinating antique gate-leg table, with delightful oak figuring and of useful size. Wonderfully provincial in taste and craftsmanship, with an ideal look for a country house kitchen or diner. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
