This is an antique travelling jewellery box. A Chinese, lacquered pine campaign case, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Delightful example of red lacquered craftsmanship
- Displaying a desirable aged patina and in good original order
- Lacquered pine presents a strikingly vibrant appearance
- Accentuated with gilt painted scenes and decorative touches
- Lid held securely with a Circular brass clasp with scallop form
- Opens to a fitted interior, with a lift-out storage tray
- Front fascia hosts a large shield-shape cutaway, with removable valance
- When removed, the aperture aids access to a trio of fitted drawers
- Each drawer dressed with a small brass drop handle, the shaped form with pierced detail
- Drop handles to each side aids ease of movement in the campaign manner
