This is an antique gentleman's money clip. A German, leather and silver plated pocket coin holder, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Fascinating and tactile pocket item, with collector coin interest
- Displays a desirable aged patina throughout
- Embossed leather padded covering in a tasteful brown hue
- Silver plate frame presents minimal tarnishing, opening in book form
- Fitted with a pair of sprung coin holders hosting two Italian 20c coins (1912 & Damp;

1921 issue) and an American Dime from 1964

- \bullet Delightful engraved concentric cross-hatch pattern detail to each sprung base
- \bullet Base plate engraved with the D.R.G.M for Deutsches Reichsgebrauchsmuster register mark
- \bullet Further engraved with a registered design number in English, presumably for export markets
